- --1970s-1980s Aku and others used to go w. wives into park and hike back out--pound `opihi and throw net (esp. as Kahue) to make money (he only worked weekends as lifeguard then)
- --Aku & brothers also went in by boat
- --Kane`ela guys, Bill Chow still went in by horse on the trail through Royal Gardens till 1986 flow after flow Jerry Dunn, Alec Harris, Sim Enriquez still trailered horses in for a while

holes for thrownet:

Ka`ena: no holes at old Ka`ena; Mauna Ulu flow [1969-74] created two moi holes below the cliff, hard to get at (he used to repel down the cliff for `opihi & found holes; Sam Kaawaloa knew also; filled w. sand by new lava flow

20 minutes: moi hole

before 20 minutes: moi hole (he found both when he went for `opihi, doesn't think anybody else knew them; got deeper w. 1975 subsidence)

other moi holes:

Kamoamoa [mentioned by Mrs. Kauhi 1996 book for 1920s]

`Aikua had two

Ka`ili`ili, behind ranger station (also used by Alan Kauhi)
