10/11/89 (signed release forms)

- 1) about his father - saw picture
after WW2 ended (1945), ~~she~~ they married / She stayed home w. parents / he only came there on furlough as when he got leave

6 mos. before the Korean War, she went to Hon. to live w. him; then July he left for war, Aug. was killed, but for 2 yrs. listed as MIA

- 2) her mother got paper from Wai'aleale - after WW2 they disappeared from pollution as what?
only her family ate the shell fish she mentioned (pulekoleka?);
^{now} she doesn't see it anymore

- 3) Ceremonies at 3:6, 10
shelphi - palekoleka
across the 'opae - Ka'ele i Ka 'opae

10/25/89 - phone call

- 1) her mother's name Robert Simey
- 2) in their household, only her + mother ~~when~~ ^{when} she went to school

earlier - her mother's niece w. them when she was a baby (Lucy + Betsy Moku), but then they went back to their ~~parent~~ parents

- a nephew of M (Robert, from another family) but he died when she was about 4, Fidelis

- her mother's aunt (sister of her mother, had adopted her mother) lived w. them till she was 5 (died before she went to school) (c. 1929)

^{sometimes stayed w. son at 'opileka, at Ho}

Rebecca Kaulua Kauliwi (her mother was a Protestant minister but she never saw him; died before her), she called her Tutu (lala) she slept in big room, they ate at one end + she slept at other end a fine - wawa mat
